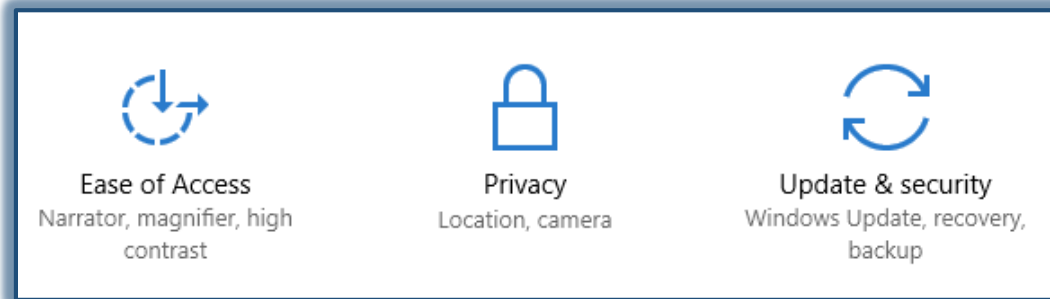
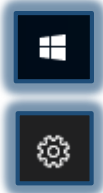


Accessibility-High Contrast

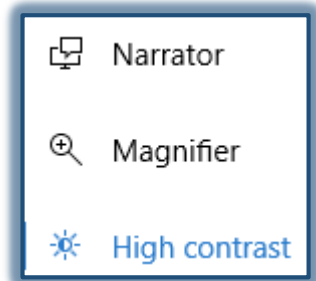
High contrast allows the user to change common elements of a window, such as background colors, text color, and hyperlinks color, that will meet individual needs

SPECIFY HIGH CONTRAST SETTINGS

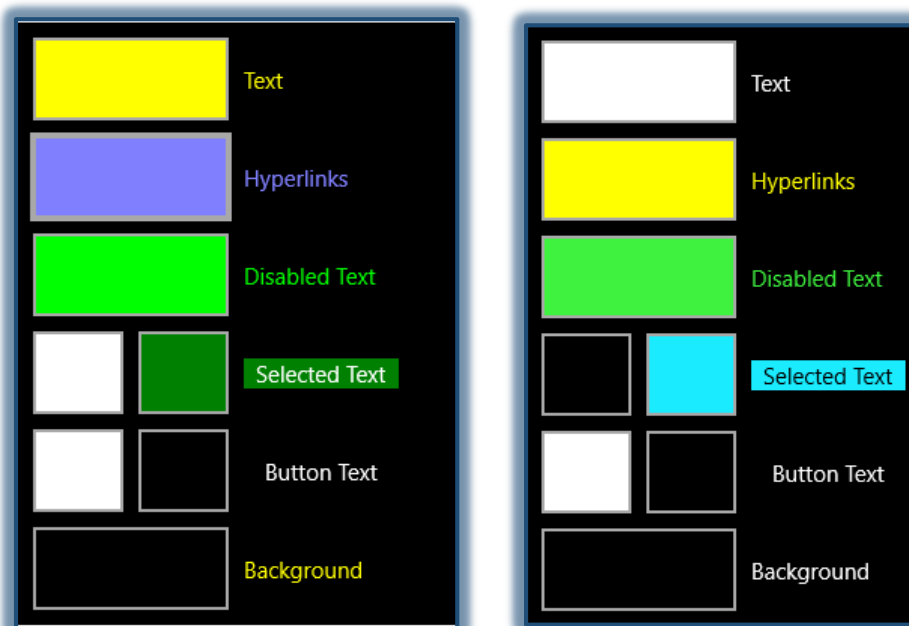
- ✚ Click the **Start** button.
- ✚ Click the **Settings** icon on the left side of the **Start Menu**.
- ✚ The **Settings** window will display.



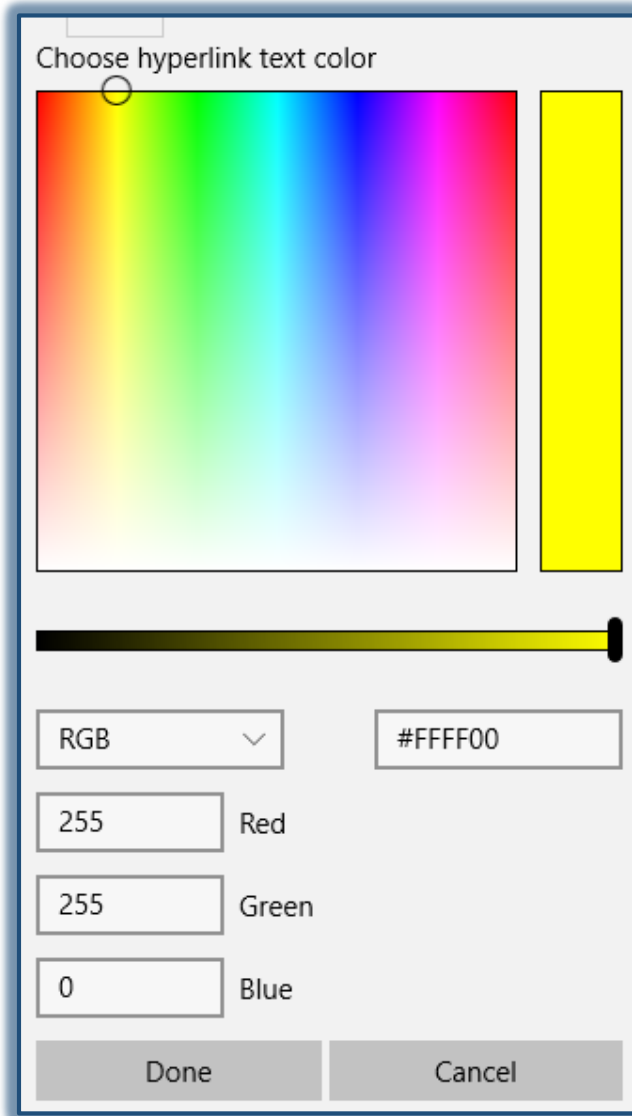
- ✚ Scroll down the page and select **Ease of Access**.
- ✚ The **Ease of Access** window will display.
- ✚ Click the **High Contrast** link.
- ✚ The **High Contrast** window will display.
- ✚ Click the list arrow to **Choose a Theme**. The options are:
 - ✧ None - This is the default setting.
 - ✧ High Contrast #1
 - ✧ High Contrast #2
 - ✧ High Contrast Black
 - ✧ High Contrast White



- ✚ The images below show examples of High Contrast #1 and High Contrast Black.
- ✚ Each of these **Themes** can be modified to meet individual needs.



- ✧ Click the **Tile** that is to be changed.
- ✧ The **Choose Text Color** window will display.



- ✧ Select a **Color** from the palette of colors.
- ✧ Use the **Slider** below the grid to change the contrast of the color.
- ✧ When the **Color** has been chosen, click the **Done** button.
- ✧ Click the **Apply** button in the **Choose Text Color** window to close the window.
