

Wii –

1. From the Wii Channel menu, select "Wii Settings" (the round button on the bottom-left of the screen with "Wii" on it).
2. Select "Internet," then "Console Settings." - The MAC address of the Wii console is displayed on the first line.

PS2 –

1. Power up the PlayStation 2 and load the Network Adaptor Startup Disc.
2. Once it has loaded, select "ISP Setup" and press X on your controller.
3. The ISP Setup will begin to load, and you will be presented with a license agreement. Select Agree and press X to continue.
4. For connection type, choose "Local Area Network (LAN)" and press X to continue.
5. Select "Automatic Configuration" and press X to continue.
6. At the connection test screen, select "Advanced" and press X to continue.
7. At the "Advanced Broadband Settings" screen, make sure "Automatic" is selected. While you are at this screen, make note of the MAC address at the bottom.

PS3 –

1. From the main menu, select Settings.
2. Scroll all the way to the bottom and select "Network Settings"
3. Selection "Settings and Connection Status List.
4. The MAC address is displayed on the screen.

PS4 –

1. Select Settings on the main menu.
2. Select Network.

3. Select View Connection Status. The combination of twelve letters and numbers next to MAC Address (LAN Cable) or MAC Address (Wi-Fi) is the MAC Address.

Xbox 360 –

1. Select "System Settings".
2. Select "Network Settings".
3. Go to "Edit Settings".
4. From "Additional Settings", select "Advanced Settings".
5. At the bottom of this screen, you'll see a heading called Wired MAC address.

Xbox One –

1. Press the Menu button on your controller, and then select Settings.
2. Select Network.
3. Select Advanced settings. The combination of twelve letters and numbers next to Wired MAC or Wireless MAC is the MAC Address

Ipad, iPhone, iPod –

1. Tap Settings
2. Tap General.
3. Tap About. The combination of twelve letters and numbers to the right of Wi-Fi Address is the MAC Address.

Android –

1. In the Settings menu under the Wireless and networks area, tap Wi-Fi.
2. In the Wi-Fi menu, tap the three vertical circles in the top-right corner of the screen or the More option. A new menu should populate on the screen. Scroll down this menu and tap Advanced.
3. In the Advanced menu, scroll down to the bottom and look for MAC address.
