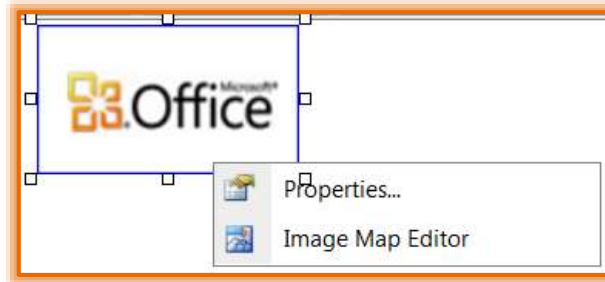


## CREATE HOT LINKS IN IMAGES

In eCollege, it is possible to create a link to an image that will allow students to open a Web page. This can be done when working in the Visual Editor of a Text/Multimedia Content Item.

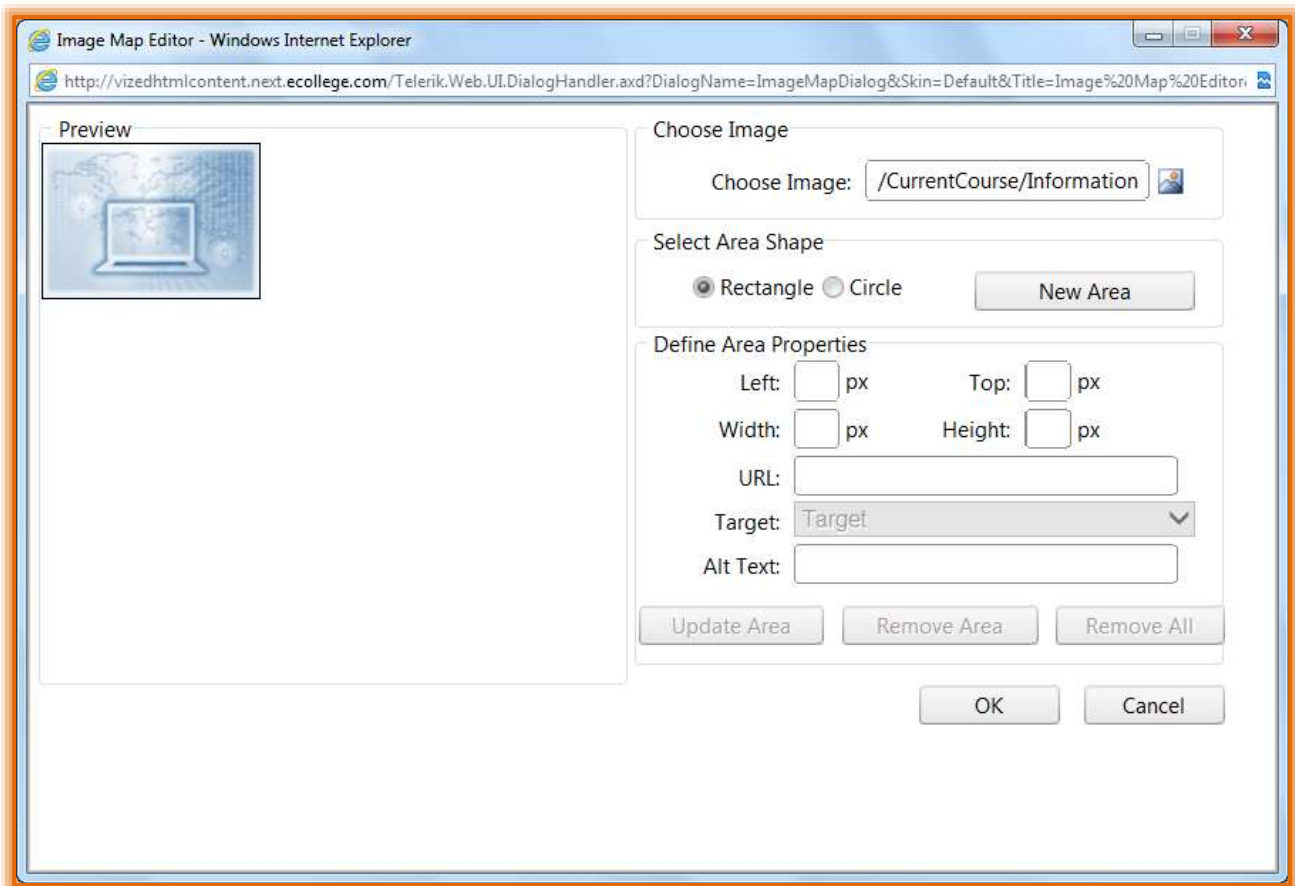
- 🖱️ Click the **Author** tab on the left side of the **eCollege** course window.
- 🖱️ Insert the image where the link is to be created.
- 🖱️ Right-click on the image to display the two available options for modifying images (see illustration below).











- 🖱️ **Properties** – This option is used to make changes to the image such as resizing.
- 🖱️ **Image Map Editor** – Use this option to add Hot-spots to an image.
  - ★ More than one hot-spot can be added per image.
  - ★ Each hot-spot can link to a different site.

🖱️ Select **Image Map Editor**.

🖱️ The **Image Map Editor** window will display (see illustration below).



-  In the **Select Area Shape** group, click one of the options.
-  Click the **New Area** button to add the hot-spot to the image.
-  Click and drag the shape across the **Image Area** that is to be clickable.
-  Enter the **Web Address** in the **URL** field.
-  In the **Target** list select how the window is to open, such as **New Window**.
-  Click **OK** to add the hot-spot links to the image.
-  Click the **Save Changes** button.
-  Click the **Course** tab to check the links.
