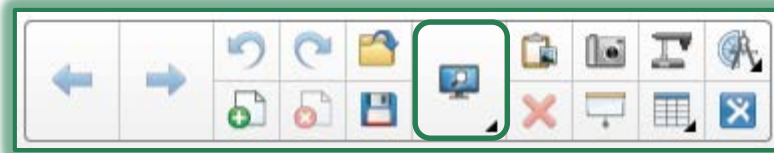


## Display Page-Dual Page View

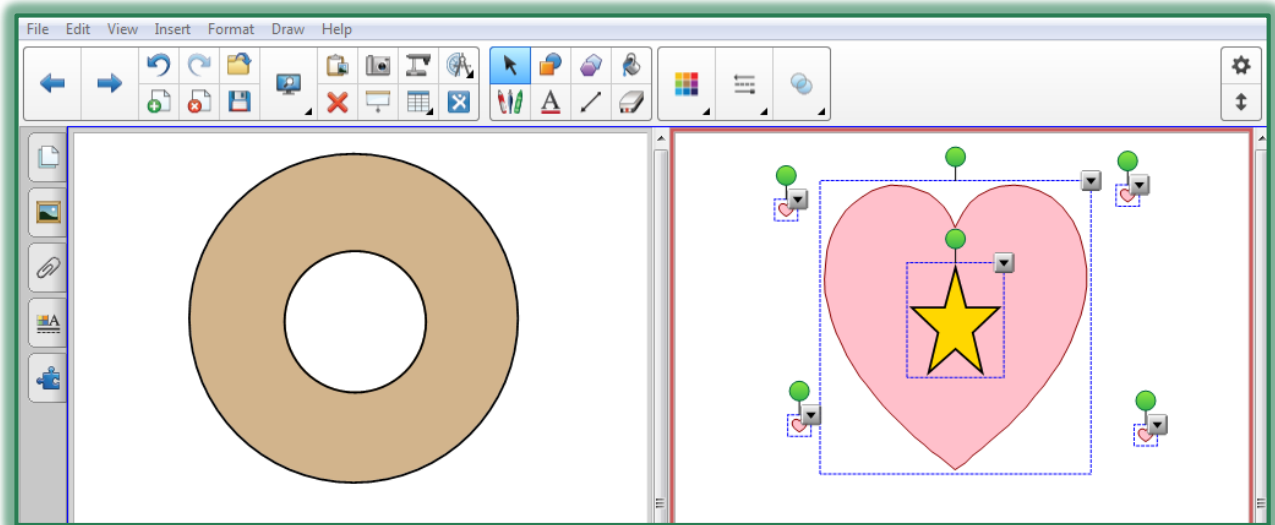
With this feature, it is possible to display two pages side-by-side. While in this view it is possible to draw, make notes, import files, and add links on either page. It is also possible to pin a page when displaying dual pages. This allows you to continue displaying the page while viewing other pages in the Page Sorter.

### DISPLAY DUAL PAGES

✦ Press or click the **View Screens** button on the **Notebook Toolbar** (see illustration below).



- ✦ Press or click **Dual Page Display**.
- ✦ Two pages of the file will display side-by-side.
- ✦ A red border will indicate the active page (see illustration below).



### PIN A PAGE

- ✦ Select the page that you want to continue to display.
- ✦ Press or click **View** on the **Menu Bar**.
- ✦ Select **Dual Page Display** from the list that appears.
- ✦ Select **Pin Page** from the next list.

### UNPIN A PAGE

- ✦ Press or click **View** on the **Menu Bar**.
- ✦ Select **Dual Page Display** from the list that appears.
- ✦ Select **Pin Page** from the next list to remove the check mark.
- ✦ This will unpin the page.

### RETURN TO STANDARD VIEW

- ✦ Press or click the **View Screens** button on the **Notebook Toolbar**.
- ✦ Clear the selection for **Single Page Display** to return to **Standard View**.
