

Display Pages-Full Screen View

In this view, the page will fill the screen by hiding the other user interface elements. It is possible to access commonly used commands while in this view.

DISPLAY PAGE BORDER







- † Press or click **View** on the **Menu Bar**.
- † Select **Full Screen Page Border** from the list of options.
- † Select the appropriate aspect ratio for the SMART Board.
- † A blue line will appear to indicate the portion of the page that will appear in Full Screen view without scrolling.

DISPLAY PAGE

- † Press or click the **View Screens** button on the **Notebook Toolbar** (see illustration below).







- † Select **Full Screen** from the list.
- † The page will expand to fill the screen.
 - ☐ The other interface elements will be hidden.
 - ☐ The **Full Screen** toolbar will appear.
- † The buttons on the **Full Screen** toolbar are described in the table below.

Command/Button	Action
Previous Page	 This button is used to display the previous page in the current file.
Next Page	 Use this button to display the next page in the current file.
More Options	 To open a menu of options, press or click this button.
Exit Full Screen	 Press or click this button to return to standard view.
Toolbar Options	 This button is used to display additional toolbar buttons.
Close	 Press or click this button to close the toolbar.

DISPLAY MORE TOOLBAR BUTTONS

- † Click the **Toolbar Options** button.
- † The toolbar will expand to include the additional buttons shown in the table below.

Command/Button	Action
Blank Page	 To insert a new blank page into the current file, press or click this button.
Undo	 This button is used to reverse the effect of the last action.
Select	 Press or click this button to select objects on the current page.
Magic Pen	 Use this button to create objects that slowly fade, open a magnification window, or open a spotlight window.

RETURN TO STANDARD VIEW

Click the **Exit Full Screen** button on the toolbar.
