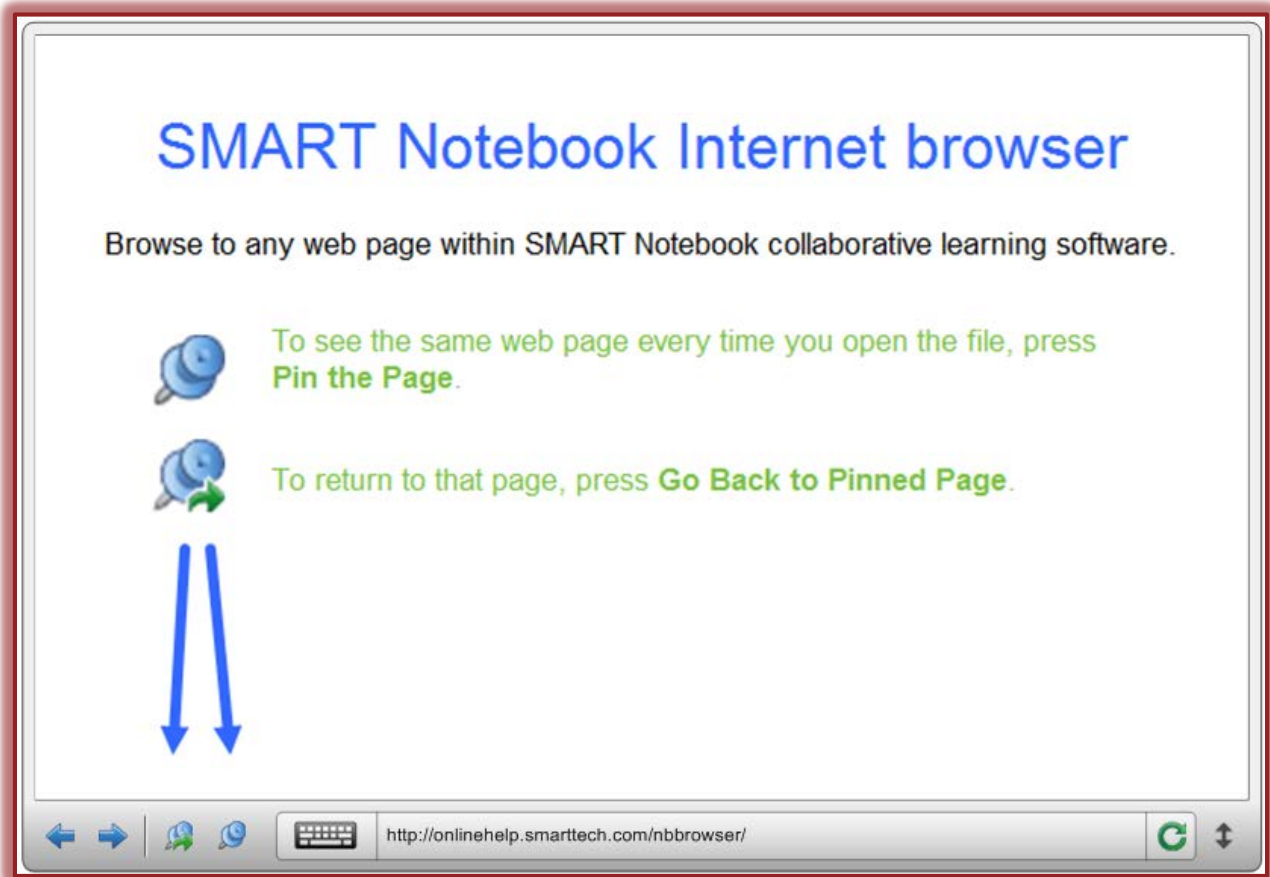


Insert Internet Browsers

An Internet Browser can be inserted into a .notebook page. In the browser, it is possible to browse to and display Web pages. The Internet browser can be modified like any other object in SMART Notebook software.



- ✦ Press or click **Insert** on the **Menu Bar**.
- ✦ Select **Internet Browser** from the list of options.
- ✦ An **Internet Browser** window will appear in the .notebook page (see illustration below).








- ✦ Double-click the **Address Bar** in the browser.
- ✦ Input the address of the **Web Page** to which you want to browse.
- ✦ Press or click the **Go** button. This is the green arrow at the end of the **Address Bar**.



- ✦ It is possible to interact with the Web site by using the **Internet Browser Toolbar**.
- ✦ The table below illustrates and explains each of the buttons on this toolbar.

Command/Button	Action
Back	 Press or click this button to move to the previous Web page in the Web site.
Forward	 To display the next Web page in the Web site, press or click this button.

Command/Button	Action
Return to Pinned Page 	A Web page can be pinned so that it will open automatically when the .notebook file is opened. This button is used to open the page when the browser is on another page.
Pin Page 	To pin the current Web page to the .notebook file, press or click this button. When the .notebook file is first opened the pinned Web page will appear in the Internet Browser. To return to the Pinned Page at any time, press or click the Return to Pinned Page button.
Keyboard 	Press or click this button to display the on-screen keyboard. This keyboard can be used to input information into the Address Bar.
Reload 	To reload the current Web page, press or click this button.
Move Toolbar 	This button is used to position the Internet Browser Toolbar to either the top or the bottom of the Internet Browser object.

NOTE: To display a different **Web Page** in the **Internet Browser**, insert the new address into the **Address Bar** and click the **Go** button.
