
Reset SMART Notebook Pages

If changes are made to a page and the changes have not been saved, then it is possible to reset the page back to the state it was before the changes. Resetting the page does not reset any Adobe Flash Player compatible files that are running on the page.

- Display the page that is to be reset.
- Press or click **Edit** on the **Menu Bar**.
- **†** Click **Reset Page**.
- The message in the illustration below will display.



† Click **Reset Page**.

NOTES:

- This option is not available if changes have not been made to the page since the file was last saved.
- † This option can also be selected by doing one of the following:
 - Right-click the page.
 - Press or click the **Page Menu Arrow** in the **Page Sorter**.
 - Press or click the **Page Menu Arrow** while editing page groups.
 - Press or click the Reset Page button on the toolbar. The toolbar would have to be customized to include this button.
- Multiple pages can be reset at the same time.
 - Press or click the page thumbnails in the **Page Sorter**.
 - Press or click the menu arrow.
 - Select Reset Page.
