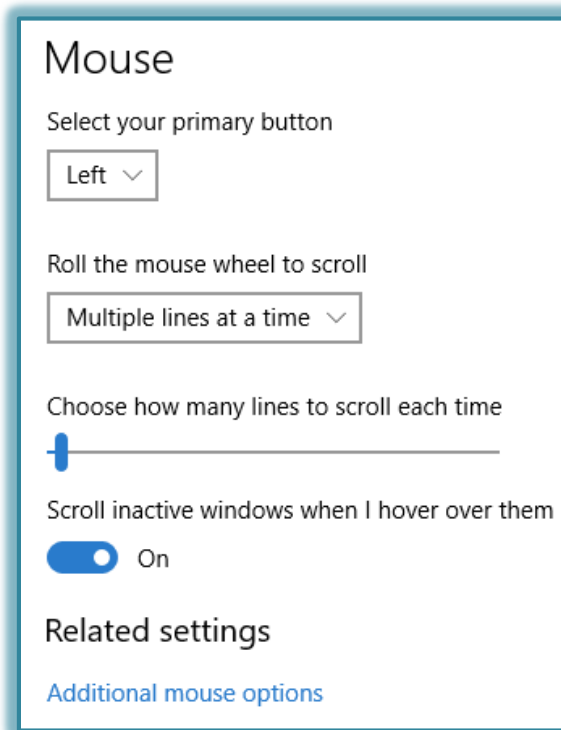


Modify Mouse Settings

It is possible to customize the computer mouse in a variety of ways. For instance, you can swap the functions of your mouse buttons, make the mouse pointer more visible, and alter the scroll speed of the mouse wheel.

- ✦ Open the **Settings** window.
- ✦ Click the **Devices** link.
- ✦ Click the **Mouse** link in the **Navigation Pane** on the left side of the window.
- ✦ The **Mouse Settings** window will display.



- ✦ Click the list arrow for **Select Your Primary Button**. The options are **Left** or **Right**.
- ✦ Choose from **Multiple Lines at a Time** or **One Screen at a Time** in the **Roll the Mouse Wheel to Scroll** list.
- ✦ If the first option, **Multiple Lines**, is selected **Specify How Many Lines to Scroll Each Time**.
- ✦ Select whether or not to **Scroll Inactive Windows**.
- ✦ Under **Related Settings**, click the **Additional Mouse Options** link.
- ✦ The **Mouse Properties** dialog box should display (see illustration on next page).
- ✦ Select the option to change from the list below:
 - ✦ **Buttons** - Use this tab to change what happens when a button is clicked.
 - ✦ **Pointers** - To change the appearance of the pointers that are used for different tasks, use this tab.
 - ✦ **Pointer Options** - To change the speed and other options of the mouse pointers, use this tab.
 - ✦ **Wheel** - Use this tab to change how the mouse acts when the wheel is used.
 - ✦ **Hardware** - To change the properties of the installed mouse, use this tab.

✚ When all the desired changes have been made, click **OK**.
