

Threaded Discussion Too Wide

In Threaded Discussion-type content items, long URLs, or web site addresses, don't wrap to the next line if they're too long. They continue on and on, on the same line, until they end. They get you to the website. However, it is difficult to have to scroll back and forth to read all of the responses in the thread.

To correct this problem and make the Threaded Discussions more readable:

- ✓ Copy and paste the long URL into the box on the <http://tinyurl.com> site.
